Parable

Meaning

- Who sows good seed: Jesus Christ (Son of man)
- The field: The World
- The good seed: Us (the sons of the Kingdom)
- The weeds: Sons of the evil one
- The harvest time: The end of the age
- The reapers: The Angels
- The sequence: All who cause sin taken out first, then the righteous will shine in the Kingdom

Revelation 14:14-20 ESV

- Then I looked, and behold, a white cloud, and seated on the cloud one like a son of man, with a golden crown on his head, and a sharp sickle in his hand. ¹⁵ And another angel came out of the temple, calling with a loud voice to him who sat on the cloud, “Put in your sickle, and reap, for the hour to reap has come, for the harvest of the earth is fully ripe.” ¹⁶ So he who sat on the cloud swung his sickle across the earth, and the earth was reaped.

Revelation 14:14-20 ESV

- ¹⁷ Then another angel came out of the temple in heaven, and he too had a sharp sickle. ¹⁸ And another angel came out from the altar, the angel who has authority over the fire, and he called with a loud voice to the one who had the sharp sickle, “Put in your sickle and gather the clusters from the vine of the earth, for its grapes are ripe.” ¹⁹ So the angel swung his sickle across the earth and gathered the grape harvest of the earth and threw it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. ²⁰ And the winepress was trodden outside the city, and blood flowed from the winepress, as high as a horse's bridle, for 1,600 stadia.

Revelation 8:1-5 ESV

- When the Lamb opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. 2Then I saw the **seven angels** who stand before God, and seven trumpets were given to them. 3And **another angel** came and stood at the altar with a golden censer, and **he was given much incense to offer with the prayers of all the saints on the golden altar before the throne**, 4and the smoke of the incense, with **the prayers of the saints**, rose before God from the hand of the angel. 5Then **the angel took the censer and filled it with fire from the altar and threw it on the earth**, and there were peals of thunder, rumblings, flashes of lightning, and an earthquake.

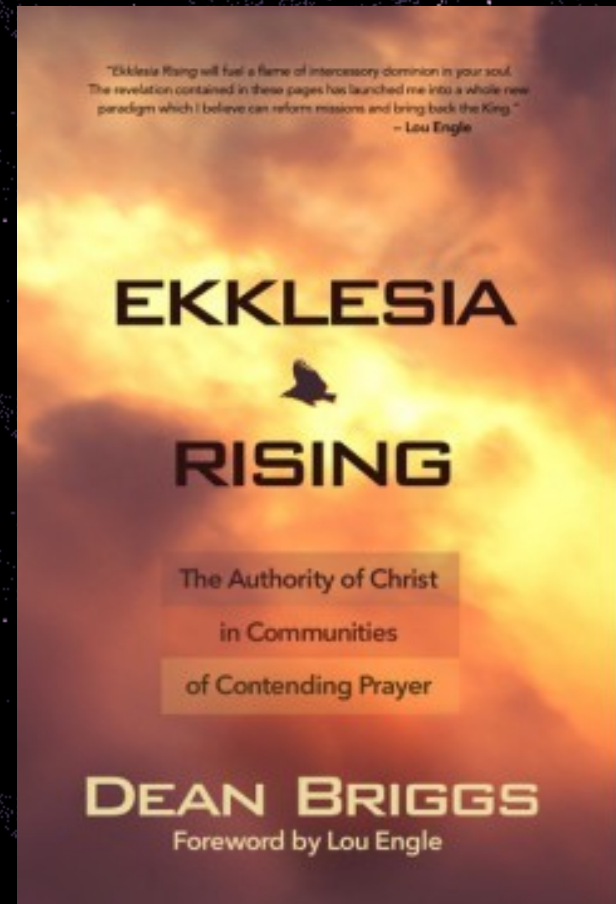


