Introduction

The background story of Acts 4 & 5

- The supernatural Power of the Holy Spirit brings exponential growth in persecution. Vs 12-16
- The Jews are filled with jealousy, indignation, and hatred of Jesus and His Followers. Vs 17-21
- The Jews took the Apostles and put them in prison, the second time (see Acts 4:3) Vs 18
- God supernaturally breaks them out of prison with an Angel giving encouragement.
 Vs 19
- The Jews mandated the second time (see Acts 4:18) to not use the Name of Jesus. Vs 27-28
- The Apostles practice Peaceful Non-Compliance and continue to preach Jesus, Vs 29
- The Apostles were beaten and given a third warning to not use the Name of Jesus. Vs 40
- They did not quit. Vs 42

4 PRINCIPLES & PRACTICE TO TAKE AWAY

- 1. When we restore First Century principles and practice, we must expect the return of First Century persecution.... even in USA!
- 2. We, as Christ Followers today, will face similar indignation and persecution for our peaceful non-compliance of mandates.
- 3. We must prepare mentally and spiritually for the consequences of disobeying the mandates imposed upon us, while obeying our God. (Revelation 13:16-17)
- 4. Our trust must rest in the provision and the protection of our King Jesus.
- 5. We, as Christ Followers today, will soon be faced with a similar choice....
