# We Must Test The Prophets and Their Words

---

- We are accustomed to agreeing or disagreeing with a prophet based on how their prophecy lines up with our personal ideas or convictions on that subject.

## WRONG TEST!

- We must first determine if they are a true prophet of God...or not.
- Then if they are a true prophet of God, the issue of whether we “like” the prophetic word, or whether we “agree” with the prophetic word, is not for us to decide.
- We must bring our ideas and convictions in line with the prophetic word.
- So they rose early in the morning and went out into the Wilderness of Tekoa; and as they went out, Jehoshaphat stood and said, “Hear me, O Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem: Believe in the LORD your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper.” II Chronicles 20:20 NKJV

# Many False Prophets

---



- 'Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but **test** the spirits to see whether they are from God, for **many false prophets have gone out into the world.** ' 1 John 4:1 ESV
- Prophets in the Kingdom must "**PASS THE TEST**"

# Beware of False Prophets

■ “Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep’s clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus you will recognize them by their fruits. Matthew 7:15-20 ESV



# 1. Does what the prophet said come to pass?

---

- 'But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in my name that I have not commanded him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, that same prophet shall die.' And if you say in your heart, 'How may we know the word that the Lord has not spoken?'— when a prophet speaks in the name of the Lord , **if the word does not come to pass or come true, that is a word that the Lord has not spoken**; the prophet has spoken it presumptuously. You need not be afraid of him.'  
Deuteronomy 18:20-22 ESV

## 2. Does what the prophet said draw your heart away from simple trust in Christ?

---

- “If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder, and the sign or wonder that he tells you comes to pass, and if he says, ‘Let us go after other gods,’ which you have not known, ‘and let us serve them,’ you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams. For the Lord your God is testing you, to know whether you love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. You shall walk after the Lord your God and fear him and keep his commandments and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him. Deuteronomy 13:1-4 ESV

### 3. Does what the prophet said line up with written word of God?

---

- “If a prophet or a dreamer of dreams arises among you and gives you a sign or a wonder, and the sign or wonder that he tells you comes to pass, and if he says, ‘Let us go after other gods,’ which you have not known, ‘and let us serve them,’ you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams. For the Lord your God is testing you, to know whether you love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul. You shall walk after the Lord your God and fear him and keep his commandments and obey his voice, and you shall serve him and hold fast to him. Deuteronomy 13:1-4 ESV

## 4. Does the prophet's character reflect the image of Jesus Christ and bare the fruit of the Holy Spirit?

---

- ' "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing but inwardly are ravenous wolves. You will recognize them by their fruits. Are grapes gathered from thornbushes, or figs from thistles? So, every healthy tree bears good fruit, but the diseased tree bears bad fruit. A healthy tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a diseased tree bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire. Thus you will recognize them by their fruits. Matthew 7:15-20 ESV
- Are they speaking out of anger or woundedness?
- Are they walking in humility?
- Does their lifestyle reflect the image and character of Christ?
- Are they in it for money, fame, power, or control?
- Have they left the world's system? ... the religious system?

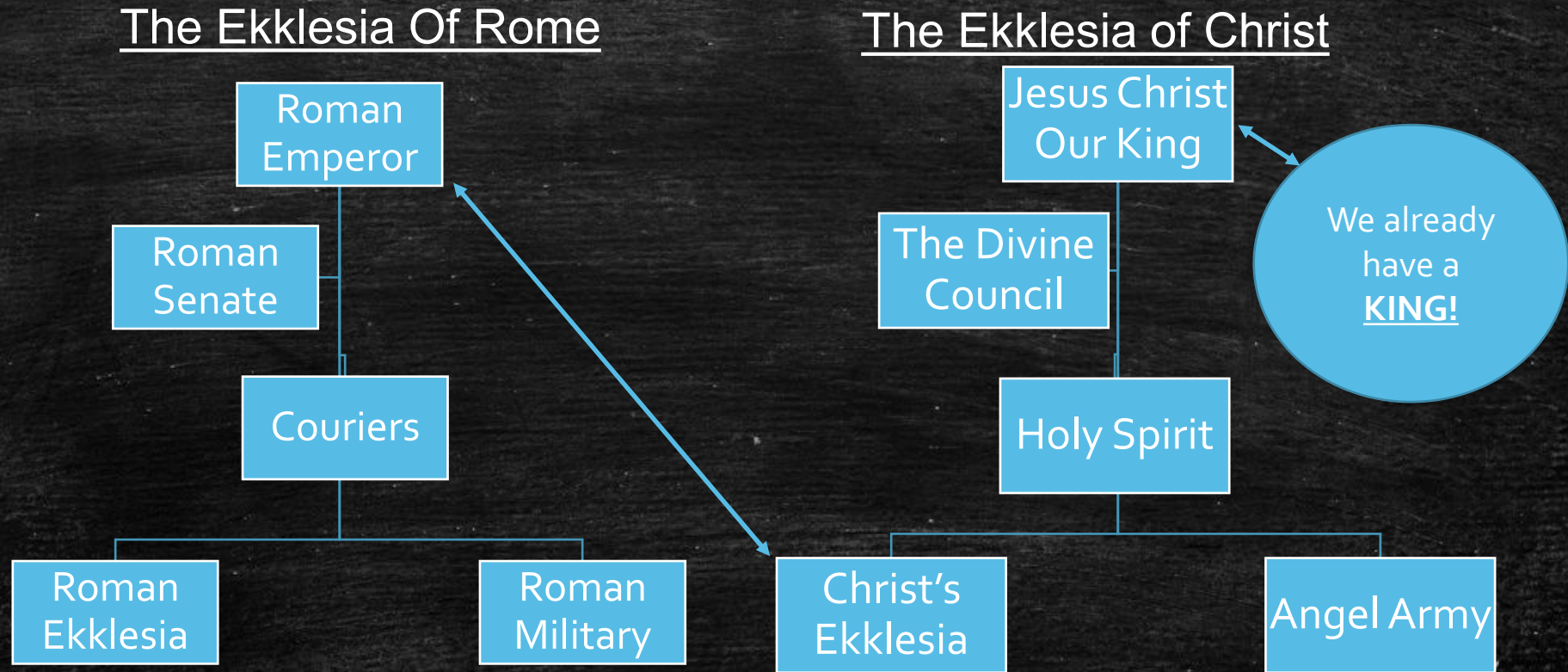


# Prophets That Pass The Test
