THERE ARE ONLY TWO COVENANT NATIONS IN THE WORLD

- Israel – God made a Covenant with Abraham & Moses (Gen. 12 & Ex. 19-24)
- United States of America – Our Founding Fathers made a covenant with God

WHEN A COVENANT NATION LEAVES GOD AND BREAKS THAT COVENANT, GOD REMOVES HIS PROTECTION AND SENDS JUDGMENT

- The removal of protection and the sending of punishment usually comes in the form of a sword, pestilence, or famine.

The Triad of God's Judgment

- **Sword** = military action by a foreign nation against the covenant nation
- **Pestilence** = devastating plagues, pandemics, and death
- **Famine** = food shortages, empty shelves at the grocery store, draught, livestock dies

The People of God Broke Their Covenant With God

- The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, saying, “Hear the words of this covenant, and speak to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and say to them, ‘Thus says the LORD God of Israel: “**Cursed is the man who does not obey the words of this covenant** which I commanded your fathers in the day I brought them out of the land of Egypt, from the iron furnace, saying, ‘Obey My voice, and do according to all that I command you; so shall you be My people, and I will be your God,’ that I may establish the oath which I have sworn to your fathers, to give them ‘a land flowing with milk and honey,’ as *it is* this day.”’ And I answered and said, “So be it, LORD.” Then the LORD said to me, “Proclaim all these words in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, saying: ‘Hear the words of this covenant and do them. For I earnestly exhorted your fathers in the day I brought them up out of the land of Egypt, until this day, rising early and exhorting, saying, “Obey My voice.” **Yet they did not obey or incline their ear, but everyone followed the dictates of his evil heart;** therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded *them* to do, but *which* they have not done.’” Jeremiah 11:1-8 NKJV

God Used a Nation More Wicked Than Israel To Deliver His Judgment.

- ‘Thus says the LORD God of Israel: “Behold, I will turn back the weapons of war that *are* in your hands, with which you fight against the king of Babylon and the Chaldeans who besiege you outside the walls; and I will assemble them in the midst of this city. I Myself will fight against you with an outstretched hand and with a strong arm, even in anger and fury and great wrath. I will strike the inhabitants of this city, both man and beast; they shall die of a great pestilence. And afterward,” says the LORD, “I will deliver Zedekiah king of Judah, his servants and the people, and such as are left in this city from the **pestilence** and the **sword** and the **famine**, into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, into the hand of their enemies, and into the hand of those who seek their life; and he shall strike them with the edge of the sword. He shall not spare them, or have pity or mercy.” ’ “Now you shall say to this people, ‘Thus says the LORD: “Behold, I set before you the way of life and the way of death. He who remains in this city shall die by the **sword**, by **famine**, and by **pestilence**; but he who goes out and defects to the Chaldeans who besiege you, he shall live, and his life shall be as a prize to him. For I have set My face against this city for adversity and not for good,” says the LORD. “It shall be given into the hand of the king of Babylon, and he shall burn it with fire.” ’
Jeremiah 21:4-8 NKJV

The People of God Mocked, Ridiculed, and Threw the Prophet of God Into a Sewage Pit

- So they took Jeremiah and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the king's son, which was in the court of the prison, and they let Jeremiah down with ropes. And in the dungeon *there was* no water, but mire. So **Jeremiah sank in the mire**. Jeremiah 38:6 NKJV

The People of God Listened to False Prophets Who Prophesied “*peace, peace, peace.*”

- “Because from the least of them even to the greatest of them, Everyone *is* given to covetousness; And from the prophet even to the priest, Everyone deals falsely. They have also healed the hurt of My people slightly, Saying, ‘*Peace, peace!*’ *When there is no peace.* Jeremiah 6:13-14 NKJV
- For they have healed the hurt of the daughter of My people slightly, Saying, ‘*Peace, peace!*’ *When there is no peace.* Jeremiah 8:11 NKJV

The Prophet of God Called the People of God To Repentance

- Then the LORD said to me, “Backsliding Israel has shown herself more righteous than treacherous Judah. Go and proclaim these words toward the north, and say: ‘Return, backsliding Israel,’ says the LORD; ‘I will not cause My anger to fall on you. For I am merciful,’ says the LORD; ‘I will not remain angry forever. Only acknowledge your iniquity, That you have transgressed against the LORD your God, And have scattered your charms To alien deities under every green tree, And you have not obeyed My voice,’ says the LORD. Jeremiah 3:12-13 NKJV
- If you will return, O Israel,” says the LORD, “Return to Me; And if you will put away your abominations out of My sight, Then you shall not be moved. Jeremiah 4:1 NKJV
- For thus says the LORD to the men of Judah and Jerusalem: “Break up your fallow ground, And do not sow among thorns. Circumcise yourselves to the LORD, And take away the foreskins of your hearts, You men of Judah and inhabitants of Jerusalem, Lest My fury come forth like fire, And burn so that no one can quench it, because of the evil of your doings.” Jeremiah 4:3-4 NKJV

The People of God Did Not Repent – And Were Taken By a Foreign Nation

- “And it shall be, when you show this people all these words, and they say to you, ‘Why has the Lord pronounced all this great disaster against us? Or what is our iniquity? Or what is our sin that we have committed against the Lord our God?’ then you shall say to them, ‘Because your fathers have forsaken Me,’ says the Lord; ‘they have walked after other gods and have served them and worshiped them, and have forsaken Me and not kept My law. **And you have done worse than your fathers, for behold, each one follows the dictates of his own evil heart,** so that no one listens to Me. Therefore **I will cast you out of this land into a land that you do not know,** neither you nor your fathers; and there you shall serve other gods day and night, where I will not show you favor.’ Jeremiah 16:10-13 NKJV

God Spared a Remnant Who Put Their Trust In Him

- “But I will gather **the remnant of My flock** out of all countries where I have driven them, and bring them back to their folds; and they shall be fruitful and increase. I will set up shepherds over them who will feed them; and they shall fear no more, nor be dismayed, nor shall they be lacking,” says the Lord Jeremiah 23:3-4 NKJV
- For thus says the Lord: After seventy years are completed at Babylon, I will visit you and perform My good word toward you, and cause you to return to this place. For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you, says the Lord, and **I will bring you back from your captivity**; I will gather you from all the nations and from all the places where I have driven you, says the Lord, and I will bring you to the place from which I cause you to be carried away captive. Jeremiah 29:10-14 NKJV
- “At the same time,” says the Lord, “I will be the God of all the families of Israel, and they shall be My people.” Thus says the Lord: “**The people who survived the sword found grace in the wilderness**—Israel, when I went to give him rest.” Jeremiah 31:2

Supreme Court Decisions

- 1962 – Bibles and Prayer out of Public Schools
