# \*\*\*MARCHING ORDERS Use Every Opportunity

## Spiritual Revolution -part 2



I have come to seek and save that which was lost. Go YOU into all the world and preach the gospel to every person.

But you shall receive power after the Holy Ghost is come upon you, and you shall be witnesses of Me in all the world.

1. When Paul was being sent to Rome, the ship had to be abandoned because of the storm. The angel of the Lord stood with Paul and told him that the 262 men on the ship would not die but the ship would be lost. The whole ship knew who he was, and Paul shared the gospel with all.

2. The people of the island where they had shipwrecked showed them kindness, fed and housed them for 3 months.

During their first night there, Paul was gathering fire wood and a viper snake bit his arm and wouldn't let go, and Paul had to pull it off.

3. The natives of the island thought Paul must be cursed, having escaped shipwreck but now killed by the highly poisonous viper.

But the bite didn't hurt him and the people then thought he must be a god.



4. So Paul **USED THE OCCASION** to preach the gospel to them, and then proceeded to HEAL many that were sick. He was **dedicated to Jesus**, **on fire** and like the good soldier of the cross, **used every chance** to get the **Word to others**.

- 5. The disciples, because of their decision to dedicate their lives to God and to **spread the gospel**, had great power given to them and healed the sick by praying or laying hands on them, as well as other miracles. Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John and saw they were ignorant men, they marveled and knew they had been with Jesus. (Acts 4:13)
- 6. They weren't always kept from harm or prison, but they used all opportunities to get the job done. They were FIREBRANDS that lit up every soul they met, possessed by the Holy Ghost. It shows that God can use anyone that is yielded and willing to do the job. Most had no higher education nor degrees.
- 7. The first disciples of Jesus, those who were trained with Him, most of them were not scholars nor educated but were normal everyday people but when they received Jesus Christ, they were changed, transformed. Then they shared the truth with all the world. (and they were just like us; we can do the same)
- 8. The one thing they did have was **DEDICATION** to stay with their training and their **marching orders to go into all the worl**d and **preach the gospel** to every person. It was not a part time job, nor one that had any government benefits.

It was **DO or DIE**, it was obey or lose. It was war, it took more dedication than a soldier, because they knew they had to give up everything including jobs, family, career, and it would **cost their lives**.

- 9. The disciples were first called <u>Christians</u> in Antioc. These were hard core seasoned soldiers of the cross who went into cities turned them upside down with teaching the gospel in the streets, in the meeting places, markets, temple, and healing people.
- 10. It was a total attack by the HAND OF GOD on them... Jesus and the Holy Spirit working in them to get the job done. Every occasion was used to give the truth no matter what the cost. We also are called to this life of all out war, all of us who know Jesus.
- 11. The Roman government eventually labeled Christians as 'terrorists' and to be imprisoned. Many died, but many were scattered everywhere from the persecution which drove the gospel out to all the world, like seeds scattered by the wind.
- 12. We hear about those who were crucified, burned alive and fed to lions in movies but we don't hear much about those who fled and went to other cities where they preached the gospel, taught others and won souls and more disciples.

- 13. That is our number one Marching Order and when our will is aligned with God's will, then the power and blessings are turned on. He begins to do the miracles. Obedience brings on the power of the Holy Spirit. The boat has to be in motion before the rudder can take effect.
- 14. Christianity was born in the **hot fires of persecution** which spread it far and wide. Jesus is leading His army and it is He that orchestrates the maneuvers. God's method was not being sitting ducks in a church on Sunday, but meeting anywhere they could, and giving the truth to every person.
- 15. Then after being empowered in their local **Ekklesia (home church)**, they went out and reached others with the gospel, the good news of salvation by faith, and being filled with the Holy Spirit. THIS was the revolution that reached the known world of that day.
- 16. As any military strategist knows, it's impossible to win a defensive war, it is doomed to failure. To win a war you have to launch an attack, you have to go on the offensive. And for the believer, it means giving the word of God to others, the sword of the spirit into the hearts of a dying world. That is the reason for the great falling away: a lack of doing the Word and will of God.



- 17. To win at any thing or any kind of battle you have to take the initiative, go on the offensive to the attack, overpower the enemy and then keep attacking. If you don't attack you won't win, but when we attack, the power is turned on and God fights for us. He loves the fighters who do His job.
- 18. This is why commando guerrilla warfare is so successful even with few people. With **sudden attacks**, in **unexpected places**, and in weak spots of the enemy's fortress, an army can do a lot of damage. We hit Satan's fortresses by boldly sharing the gospel in every and any situation.
- 19. Our warfare is spiritual; our enemies are the demons and Satan himself who control much of this world. Our weapons are different from the military but the tactics of spiritual war are the same or similar. As we go on the attack, He pours on the power, doors open, hearts open and opportunities open.

- 20. You choose the time and place and strike with lightning speed, first here then there and set the enemy back on his heels, only then to disappear to strike in another place. This is how the Russian army was able to destroy Napoleons army... by picking them off one by one, as they retreated.
- 21.One teen guerrilla warrior David defied a whole army by bringing down their champion Goliath, and sent the army of the Philistines running.
  One warrior Samson defied and destroyed the leaders of a whole nation of the enemy, bringing down the house on their heads in one great last show of power.
- 22. One Warrior, Jesus Christ, came, saw and conquered this world by dying for us, and trained others to carry on the revolutionary kingdom of Heaven in the souls of the lost. For this purpose was the Son of God manifested, that He would DESTROY the works of the Devil. (I John 3:8)

Gideon called by the Lord, went up against a very large army with his 300 men and decimated them by listening to God's instructions. GOD fought for them.

23. Jonathan and his armor bearer said, God is not limited by many or few and he went and defied a garrison of the enemy. If you have God with you, you are unbeatable no matter how small you are. It

pays to dedicate yourself to the Lord and His commission, His marching orders. Hear from Him on the specifics in prayer and prophecy, and launch an attack.

24 This is the picture Jesus spoke of... the gates of hell shall not prevail against the onslaught of the 'ekklesia', the army of Christian believers and doers, who go on the offensive to the attack and win the world to Jesus.



25. He didn't mean the believers were sitting in a building with a cross on it, hiding out and able to withstand the attacks of the world and the enemy, but they, the believers were taking the attack TO THE ENEMY and winning the world. Just as we are doing when we share the truth with others in whatever ways He leads us.

- 26. Whether it is the digital warriors attacking on the 'fields' of battle of social media, web sites or whether it is hand to hand combat with speaking the truth of the gospel to individuals or groups wherever we go, the battle is the same.
- 27. The political digital war has become spiritual as we expose WHO is really behind the cabal, the globalists, the media, and their pawns and agents. We have exposed that **they worship and serve Satan** openly. It's in their writings, symbols, ceremonies and agenda; their goal of world government means they have to destroy **God in us, and wipe out Christianity** for we are **their main enemy.**
- 28. Those who seek truth in the political usually end up finding Jesus as He is the main force against the Cabal, so searching for answers and truth leads to more. The Words of God ARE enlightenment that illumine our minds and souls that when mixed with obedience, destroys the enemy's strongholds in the minds and hearts of the world.
- 28 b. The goal of the cabal is to brainwash, weaken and dominate the world. They want to expunge godly, Christian culture out of the world, out of the hearts and minds, for that gives them domination, that gives them power over weakened souls who sell out for the things of this world or not interested to seek truth.

- 29. The main battle for the Christian is to get the Word of God to all the world, for that was the main marching order from the King Himself. GO YE! WHY? Because the world, the whole world is waiting for the word of God, for salvation of their souls. They don't even know Jesus yet... and God wants to give them all a chance.
- 30. Can you imagine it? The whole world is waiting on US to give them the answers to life. Without Jesus and the Word there is no life... 'for I am the way, the truth and the life, no man comes unto the Father without Me. (John 14:6) And they need to see a hot, inspired, radical believer who loves the Lord, and not some half baked church goer that doesn't offer much at all.
- 31. Neither is there salvation in any other for there is NO other name under heaven given to mankind, whereby we will be saved. (Acts 4:12). We who carry the gospel to the world are the saviors of humanity and all history is pivoted on us. God moves the world around us, not the cabal.
- 32. The Great Awakening is part of the war, to open the eyes of the world, for it is hard to control and manipulate an awakened public with a conscience. But our main job according to the King is to reach the souls of all the world with salvation, for that is forever, and the only way sin and evil will be destroyed.



33. Being connected directly to God, filled with the Holy Spirit is the power source of all goodness, faith, freedom, joy, and eternal life. If God be IN us nothing can stop us. Once we have momentum by pouring out to the world, that is when the miracles kick in. And like the missionary told the young man who asked, 'why are there so few missionaries', the pastor replied, so few are willing to pay the price.

34. The Word of God is the salt, and those who have His Word in them and obey it become the salt of the earth to cleanse, make tasty, and preserve... all the uses of salt.

Salt to cleanse from sin; salt to preserve our souls for His use, and salt to make us tasty so the world sees Jesus in us and desires what we have. But if the salt loses its flavor, by letting the world and sin

take over, we get weak and lose the battle of the Spirit.

35. Do we really believe the Bible, the Words of Jesus and the words of the apostles, the disciples, the followers of Jesus who like soldiers, went into the battle no matter what the cost, to **deliver the blows of God to WIN the world** with the truth. Are we obeying the Lord or are we becoming like the churches, satisfied with a little fellowship and then forget about the lost souls.

# **Die Daily**

- 36. It is a spiritual war, one which must be fought daily with relentless attacks. First by putting the Word in us and our children, friends and relatives and then launching some kind of attack to reach others. (prophecy: I will bless and supply miraculously for My disciples who wage spiritual war against the forces of hell)
- 37. It is this kind of dying daily to our laziness, fears, and worldly pastimes that is the hardest. Giving up the things of the world to give the truth to others (in the ways He leads us personally), that is the test of true active believers. The battle isn't making time for fellowship, the battle begins when we leave the ekklesia, fellowship or church, and face the world of lost souls.

- 38. It is WE that must launch the attack. Face the fears to go on the offensive with the truth of Jesus Christ. Resist the enemy and he will flee from you. Know what you believe, be empowered by the truth and then do it. We have the life giving words, the Spirit of Christ; we have the love of God and the precious Holy Spirit that the world desperately needs.
- 39. Face the fear of man in the power of the Holy Spirit on the promises of His word and launch an attack and you cannot lose. Sure the enemy fires back as he will not give up territory that belongs to him without a battle. God wins the battle when we launch an offensive. When we go on the initiative to pour out on the lost, it activates the power to win.
- **39 b.** Go ye into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

And He sent them to preach the kingdom of heaven and to heal the sick.

So likewise whoever he be that forsakes not all he has, he cannot be My disciple.

And daily they ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.

Go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost.

That by the space of 3 years, I ceased not to teach and preach Jesus Christ.

For the the preaching of the cross is to them that perish, foolishness, but unto us it is the power of God. But you shall receive power after the holy ghost is come upon you and you shall be witnesses of Me, unto the uttermost part of the earth. And I will never leave nor forsake you.

## **Move Out**

- 40. To stay alive we must have movement, there must be change, motion, movement and the signs of life are manifested in action.
- There are only two directions any army can go, there is no standing still.
- 41. You are either going forward, making progress or you are going backwards, backsliding, just as in any war or attack. Sure, there are times for regrouping, training, preparing for the next battle, but those are also positive actions.
- 42. When we as believers, active soldiers of the cross, disciples, do not make any spiritual progress, not going ahead in raising the spiritual strength and giving to others, we are losing the battle. Just as the so called 'church' lost its fire and drifted slowly back into the world, so you cannot even tell the difference between them and the world.

- 43. The world and our enemy won over the Churches because the Christians gave up their attack and sat around as the communists and ungodliness were on the attack, ripping off their children, and letting the Christians die the slow death of spiritual genocide, by brainwashing their children against the truth, and by their relentless attacks.
- 44. To stay alive we must have action, progress, and growth both as individuals and groups of believers. The original plan was that the ekklesia or the meetings of the believers were for our empowerment, our encouragement, our training and then when we left the meetings the war began for souls.
- 45. What is the war? It is **reaching the world**, with the Love of Jesus Christ. That is the vision, that is the plan and that is our marching order... and the job the Lord commanded us to do. A soldier on the battle field has no option or choice. He must shoot or be killed. It seems most of the churches are full of deserters or those who never intended to fight.

## **VISION**

46. A loss of vision to do the job can be traced back to a loss of power, the vision of what the job is and the incentive to do it. If we have the vision we know that our job is to reach the whole world



with the gospel, the really good news of salvation and joy of the Lord.

47. A loss of initiative and progress without any fire to get up and do the will of God, is from a loss of vision, and that loss of vision is from a break in our connection to the power source. There's a break in the current of power because you no longer take action, as you become sidetracked by the noise of the trinkets of the world. Negligence to study the Word causes you to lose the hot connection to the Lord which is our power.

48. The attacking initiative is created by the vision. The vision of having the power of Jesus Christ in us and KNOWING that everyone needs this. Everyone needs salvation today.

That conviction creates the power, the action, the doing, the going, the obedience to the marching order of our King

- 49. The four things that make a pioneer are vision, faith, initiative, courage, the guts to do it.... When we connect to Jesus, He gives us the vision which creates faith and conviction to have the boldness to take the initiative and obey.
- 50. So how do so many people lose the vision. They lose the vision from a break in the connection to the power source. Somehow through neglect, laziness, lethargy, inaction, there is the loss of power from God Himself. They lose their individual connection to the Lord from disobedience.

(Like the husband who asks loudly why the TV doesn't work, I can't see a thing; and his wife says... plug it in stupid.)

- 51. Then the loss of power turns to a loss of belief and faith, which leads to fear and inaction, a loss of the fighting spirit to obey no matter what. We become prisoners of war as the enemy has not only stopped us but has tied us up with the things of this world.
- 52. If you lose that pioneering spirit, that fire that you just have to take action to establish the kingdom of God on the earth and if you are satisfied with what you have, you begin to die spiritually and backslide into worldliness.

- 53. When we stop pioneering, taking the initiative and go on the attack to win, to give, to take over the world for Jesus, we begin to fail. God's law of progress is, if you don't keep gaining more ground, you lose what you have. (parable of the talents)
- 54. On the other hand, as we listen to the Lord, and obey Him, He empowers us, supplies, blesses, opens doors and will do anything for us because we are willing to trust and **obey**, no matter what the cost, to do the job.

## Scriptures

- 55. (and again) But you shall receive power after the Holy Ghost is come upon you and you shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, Judea and unto the uttermost parts of the earth. (Acts 1:8)
- 56. The spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound. (Isaiah 61:1)
- 57. From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the kingdom of heaven is at hand. (Mathew 4:17)
- 58. And as **you** go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. (Mathew 10:7)

- 59. And it came to pass, when Jesus had made an end of commanding his twelve disciples, he departed to teach and to preach in their cities. (Mathew 11:1)
- 60. And he said unto them, Let us go into the next towns, that I may preach there also: for therefore came I forth. (Mark 1:38)
- 61. And how shall they preach, except they be sent? as it is written, How beautiful are the feet of them that preach the gospel of peace, and bring glad tidings of good things. (Romans 10:15)
- 62. For though I preach the gospel, I have nothing to glory of: for necessity is laid upon me; yea, woe is unto me, if I preach not the gospel. (I Cor: 9:16)
- 63. Furthermore, when I came to Troas to preach Christ's gospel, and a door was opened unto me of the Lord. (2 Cor. 2:12)
- 64. For we preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord; and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake. (2 Cor. 4:5)
- 65. To preach the gospel in the regions beyond you... (2 Cor. 10:16)
- 66. When I say unto the wicked, You shall surely die; and you give him not warning, nor speak to warn the

wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand. (Ezekiel 3:18)

#### Notes:

- 67. All saved Christians and those who have received the Holy Spirit are ordained of God to preach the gospel in some way. Not all are called to live a missionary life, but all are called to give the truth to the lost.
- 68. Enjoying the blessings and not giving them, is like having a pure, crystal stream or a well of pure water in the desert. It would be criminal for us to withhold the water from those dying of thirst.
- 69. Those who cannot share the gospel and to reach all nations, can pray for and support those who do. Those able and willing to do the job need help to do it This is the failure of a lot of the 'church system', their failure to train their people to do the job that we are commanded to do.
- 70. Preaching the gospel to the same people every week is like overstuffing some people with food while billions around them are starving for one morsel.
- 71. Compromise has been the downfall of Christianity. Compromising with the system for money and other benefits.

True Christians are not popular as they always go against the status quo of the beast and the world.

- 72. Standing up for the gospel and giving it in a spirit of God's love, is the most powerful force on earth for it will live on after this world is gone. The seed always bears fruit.
- 73. We can't back down because of cancel culture. They exist because WE didn't do the job of reaching their souls, or allowing the system to take over education which always means secularism.
- 74. If they persecute you in one place, go to another until there is no place but up.
- 75. Those people and countries that have the most gospel have the most responsibility to share it in love. When they see the love of Jesus in us, they want it. If they only feel a condemning, judgmental attitude, it will drive them away.
- 76. We can change our areas or areas of influence first by praying consistently for them and then giving the truth in the ways that are area-friendly, that have the best potential for them to grasp and receive it.
- 77. Before Trump, every president for decades was going in the wrong direction or were controlled by the cabal. This led to stripping the gospel from

schools, society,, and flooding the people with endless garbage and poisons. These are attacks of the enemy destroy Christian culture.

78. It is our job to restore faith by reaching a person at a time, to at least give them a chance. Living the Word sets up godly culture, brings a standard of truth, conviction and God into our area. When the Bible and believing Christians are removed, then savagery and godlessness come.

PLANT THE FLAG OF FAITH in the hearts and minds of the world to obey the Lord and save humanity.



#### Comment

Remember the words of St Francis who said, 'Preach the gospel everywhere you go; sometimes use words'.

In other words, our sample of the love of Christ is the best sermon. Samples sell sermons... The world may not be receptive, but all need a chance. We may be their last chance, and having the love and joy of Christ in our hearts, is the key to their souls.

As John Wesley said, 'I just get on fire for Jesus, and the world comes out to see me burn.'

The sunset of history is setting and soon time will be no more. What will we be known and remembered for.
