2 The #1 question I get from those transitioning from Church to Ekklesia:

"What should we do about giving our tithes and offerings?"
Giving to the King is different than giving to the Church "Building Fund."
If your giving is motivated by wanting to get a tax credit in return, are you really giving?

Where did the early Christians give their offerings?

Let's return to the original model!

What does the Bible say?

It is our book for faith and practice.

3 Giving A Tithe To The King Was Initiated Before The Law Was Given

- "Then Melchizedek King of Salem brought out bread and wine; he was the priest of God Most High. And he blessed him and said: "Blessed be Abram of God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; And blessed be God Most High, Who has delivered your enemies into your hand." And he (Abram) gave him Melchizedek) a tithe of all." Genesis 14:18-20 NKJV
 - .
- 2 Abraham initiated tithing to the King approximately 400 years BEFORE Moses was given the 10 Commandments.
 - "Tithe" is middle English for 1/10 or 10%
 - ESV & NIV = "Tenth"
 - Properly understood, tithing is not legalism!

4 Melchizedek: A Type of Jesus Christ Our King Hebrews 7:1-10 NKJV

• For this Melchizedek, King of Salem, priest of the Most High God, met Abraham returning from the slaughter of the kings and blessed him, and to him Abraham apportioned a tenth part of everything. He is first, by translation of his name, King of righteousness, and then he is also King of Salem, that is, King of peace. He is without father or mother or genealogy, having neither beginning of days nor end of life, but resembling the Son of God he continues a priest forever. See how great this man was

to whom Abraham the patriarch gave a tenth of the spoils!

5 The Lord Has Commanded: The Tithe Belongs To Him

• "Every tithe of the land, whether of the seed of the land or of the fruit of the trees, is the LORD's; it is holy to the LORD. If a man wishes to redeem some of his tithe, he shall add a fifth to it. And every tithe of herds and flocks, every tenth animal of all that pass under the herdsman's staff, shall be holy to the LORD. One shall not differentiate between good or bad, neither shall he make a substitute for it; and if he does substitute for it, then both it and the substitute shall be holy; it shall not be redeemed." These are the commandments that the Lord commanded Moses for the people of Israel on Mount Sinai. Leviticus 27:30-34 NKJV

6 In The Revelation The Remnant is Defined

- 'And the dragon was wroth with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ' Revelation 12:17 KJV
- 'Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. 'Revelation 14:12

For we must always cherish the words of our Lord Jesus, who taught, 'Giving brings a far greater blessing than receiving.'" Acts 20:33-35 TPT

12 What Did the Ekklesia Practice?

• 'Now the multitude of those who believed were of one heart and one soul; neither did anyone say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all. Nor was there anyone among them who lacked; for all who were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the proceeds of the things that were sold, and laid them at the apostles' feet; and they distributed to each as anyone had need.' Acts 4:32-35

 - 40% Staff Salaries & Programs
 - 10% Missions
 - 10% Denominational Support
- 3 OKM Home Congregations (Kingdom Giving)
- 4 80% 9 Gift Checks sent to Bless & Encourage the Apostolic Team to Expand the

Kingdom through their ministry of Training and Coaching. The gift amount we sent for the past two years was recently cut in half.

- 20% Equipping the Saints, through Broadcast Media (19 Zoom Pro Accounts, Equipping Ekklesia Broadcast, More Than Conquerors Broadcast, Two Websites: OKMtraining & .tv, and soon Ekklesia Radio). Budget Need = \$9,000 / Month
- No building, no staff salaries, no insurance policy, no programs, no denominational support.
