Grace be with you, mercy and peace from God the Father and from Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love. (I John 2:3)

And this is His commandment...

For pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep yourself unspotted from the world. (James 1:27)

But who ever has this world's goods, and see his brother have need, and shuts up his heart of compassion from him, how dwells the love of God in him?(I John 3:17)

And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment. (I John 3:23)

These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. (I John 5:13)

"Let me put it another way. The law was our guardian until Christ came; it protected us until we could be made right with God through faith." (Galatians 3:24)

The old system under the law of Moses was only a shadow, a dim preview of the good things to come, not the good things themselves. The sacrifices under that system were repeated again and again, year after year, but they were never able to provide perfect cleansing for those who came to worship. (Hebrews 10:1)(NLT)

For the Law was given by Moses but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ. (John 1:17)

Wherefore My brethren you also are become **dead to the Law** by the **body of Christ** that we should **be married to another**, even to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bring forth fruit unto God. (Romans 7:4)

For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision accomplishes anything; what matters is faith working through love. (Galatians 5:6)

Therefore **stand fast in the liberty** where Christ has made us free and be not entangled in the yoke of bondage. (Galatians 5:1)

Because, what the Law [of Moses] could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law (Romans 8:2,3)).

The Law of Moses was written in stone, but **the law of Christ is inscribed by the Spirit in our hearts**. (Jeremiah 31:31)

Therefore **love is the fulfillment of the law**, for love does no harm to his neighbor. (Romans 13:10)

And again I say... Owe no one anything, except to **love** each other, for the one who loves another has **fulfilled** the law. (Romans 13:8)

Greater love has no man than this, that he lay down his life for his friend. You are My friends if you do whatsoever I command you. (John 15:13,14)
