ATTACK MODE Christian Club or Soldiers



Defining a Christian

*(note: This message is not meant to make anyone feel bad because they are not able to do this life style. I'm only setting the record straight for what a Christian really is, so that there is the standard to go by. It doesn't mean that the Lord can't use people where they are at, because He does, and all have their gifts and talents. When looking at this document and holding mega churches and so called Christian leaders up to it, we find that they are not really in the same league at all... and yet it is quite possible to live a similar life style as the

early Christian fighters. The standard has been set in decades past by people that were not really living the talk... so I feel it's important to see what the standard really is.)

- 1. The disciples of Jesus were first called Christians in Antioch Turkey. The Apostles, the full time fighters of Jesus Christ, those who were trained and commanded to go into all the world town by town, country to country and heart to heart, were soldiers of the cross, not casual believers.
- 2. What were they doing in Turkey? Why are 7 of the churches mentioned in Revelations 2 and 3 ALL in Turkey? That's where it was most fruitful at that time. Because of persecution from the leaders of the Jews, the Sanhedrin, the Christians had to split to other countries and that was good, because they found out that the Gentiles received them and many received Jesus and became disciples. The point is they were so onfire that the system persecuted them.
- 3. That's a different picture than what we know today as Christian. Todays Christian is more like a club where you go once or twice a week to hear a sermon, sing a little, and the kids can go to Sunday school for some Bible stories and activities. It's more like 'a Christian paint job, than getting a whole new car.

- 4. You know, you have an old car and you want to make it look good, so you paint it. But that car is still the old car that breaks down and needs a lot of repair, and even a total overhaul and new engine. It looks new but it's the same old car.
- 5. The 'Christian club paint is the same. It's painting over with what looks like Christian, they speak the same words and read the same Bible, but it is actually just a paint job of temple worship or a watered down version. It's not that the churches haven't done some good, for they have, and there are many precious people there...
- 6. But it's not a revolution, it's not changing the world, it's not reaching the world and turning it upside down for the gospel; for many of the big churches, it's compromise with the world to gain members, like a social club or business, a Christian business or club.
- 7. Christianity of the disciples was a total revolution that you gave everything to, you gave up on this world, and lived for one thing... to reach the world with the gospel. You banded together in ecclesia, home congregations to fellowship, pray, train disciples, get empowered, and then go out to reach the dying souls... all out commitment.

Attack Mode

1. The Word from the King, the Son of God, Jesus Christ to the disciples, the Christians, the fighters

- was... GO YE. Go and preach the good news of the kingdom of heaven and make disciples of all nations. The disciples, the Christians were fighters whose job was to reach the world with the gospel. They not only believed but <u>lived</u> the gospel.
- 2. What do most of the 'Christians' of the world believe not with their words but with their actions? Isn't it most of the time a paint job, a social club, a life of compromise with the world? Most Christians are not laying down their lives for the gospel, they put up with going to church because they feel they have to; it's their duty.
- 3. Not all churches are like that, but in general, that is what the church system 'believes'. They preach a good talk, but their actions are quite different. It's good for those who cannot be soldiers, but it's not the life of disciples.

We usually do what we believe... meaning, we act out what we drink into our soul and that belief becomes the dominate force and factor in our life. You do what you believe, and even if you are having to live in the system, still in your heart and your words and actions, you live Christianity, you 'do' Jesus.

4. Christian fighters, believers, and doers, eat God, drink God, sleep with God, and do God. We do Jesus. What do you do? I do God. What are you? I'm a doer, a fighter, a disciple of Jesus, a Christian. I do God, and that is what the word Christian meant.

- 5. That might sound like a radical doctrine and it is. Christianity is the most radical 'religion' in this world for it is a total revolution from the death of this world. Real Christianity rends your heart right out and replaces it with a new one... a new engine, not a paint job.
- 6. Being a Christian is like being a guerrilla soldier of the cross. He lives in Enemy controlled territory and cannot confront 'the beast' in conventional methods of war, but is low key, attacks here, there, and everywhere, while the enemy reels from blow after blow of the fighters. The enemy doesn't know where you are going to hit next, and is on the defensive.
- 7. Guerrilla warfare is a form of irregular war in which small groups of combatants, such as paramilitary personnel, armed civilians, or irregulars, use military tactics including ambushes, sabotage, raids, small attacks, hit-and-run tactics, and mobility, to fight a larger and less-mobile traditional military.
- 8. This is why guerrilla warfare is so effective and successful, because even with few numbers, weapons and supplies, by sudden attacks in unexpected places, at weak spots in the Enemy's fortress, with consistent raids, they are able put a larger force on the defensive and they begin to weaken.
- 9. The Enemy can't find you so easily. You are on the move, hitting here and there with the truth, and then you leave to hit in another place. They don't even

know who you are, because you operate underground, incognito and quietly you do the job. You hit and run before the enemy knows what hit him.

- 10. You choose the time and place and strike with lightning speed then disappear before they can retaliate. You have declared war by your actions, not just with words, and you run the sword of truth into the heart of the world, into the souls around you, just as Jesus continually did. Jesus was on the attack, getting out truth, doing miracles, bringing down the kingdom into the hearts of the receptive.
- 11. As every military strategist knows it is impossible to win a defensive war. To win a battle and the war you have to launch an attack, you have to go on the offensive with consistent blows to set the enemy back on his heels, to invade and overpower. Just trying to hold back the enemy as he attacks is doomed to failure and that is what happened to 'Christianity'.
- 12. That is the reason globalism, communism, worldliness has taken over the world. Socialism, statism and communism (slavery) is making more progress in taking over the world, because they constantly attack. The enemy relentlessly hits the people with their message, and their poisons.
- 13. The globalists, the banker corporate elite took over the world and are now dictating to us 'terms of surrender'. They roll out their agenda and tell us, this is what you will do, and if you don't we will destroy

your country, your economy and slaughter you with viruses, vaccines and poisons in your food.

- 14. The enemy is now dictating their terms because the Christians went to sleep in complacency and compromise with the world. We ceased to fight and attack the devil's forces, compromised and joined the world. They just mutter a few words from the Bible, and utter some weak prayers but it has no power, no authority, because it's not backed with action.
- 15. This is spiritual warfare and the picture is not of sitting in our fortresses (churches) and holding out against an attacking enemy who is out to destroy you, as you wait for rescue! The picture is of us going out everywhere and delivering blow after blow of truth to reach the captives, the prisoners of war with the Word of God.
- 16. You get weak from sitting still. You lose ground in heart and spirit from lack of action, in defensive mode. You not only lose ground but you get TAKEN OVER by the demonic forces of the world because you allowed them to. In our false sense of security, we let down our guard and the enemies ran in and took over the hearts and minds of the youth.
- 17. It's never too late to change, to stop living in a dream world, living like everything is okay and there is rescue coming. We HAVE to rise up in power of conviction to attack the enemy, pour out the truth on others, and continue to attack. Attack mode is the

only way you win a battle and the war. As we attack God fights for us.

- 18. Sure you may get wounded and there are 'casualties', but we have the right message and the right commander in chief so we win even if it looks like we lose a battle, because God's truth and Words do the job if we will deliver them. He stands by His Word, so we win if we attack. We lose ground when we stand still.
- 19. Have you lost the compulsion that you just have to make progress, you have to die to self to get the job done or you will dry up inside? If we do not have the fighting spirit to get the truth to others, we are dying inside, gangrene has set in and we may lose a leg. As the monk said when asked, 'aren't your trainees kind of young'? He said, you are old, I am old, we are all old because we could die tomorrow.
- 20. In other words, today is the only day we have. We have to make the decision whether to be a fighter for truth or hide out in the fort, or even worse, become a traitor and work for the Enemy. Judas was numbered with the disciples but was not there in heart and spirit. He was not believing enough to have the radical transformation of soul.
- 21. We have forgotten what we joined the army for, the Christian army, the soldiers of the cross. We thought it was all peace and easy street. We sat at ease in Zion thinking we were strong, when actually the enemy encircled us and wore down the walls

piece by piece. Jesus Christ called us to WAR, to GO and reach the world with the gospel, the truth, the word of God and make fighters.

- 22. Our main job is to get the message out to the world in some way or in many ways, to hit the enemy here and there with truth. We are compelled and constrained to go, to reach the youth, to teach all people the Word of God and give eternal life to those who are open to it... and if they aren't open to it, then go where they are. That is our job and it's time to rise up and pour out on the world while we can.
- 23. If you determine in your heart to fight, to obey, to be a fighter, a Christian, then Jesus will meet you, God will empower and lead you. You show Him you are willing by your actions, and He will show you He means business. He will pour out His power and blessings on you.. but He can't bless until we obey.
- 24. Obedience brings on the blessings of God. Going on the attack in some way opens the door for the Lord to empower and do the miracles. Sure it may take some consistent obedience before God kicks into gear, but He will. He just may be testing you a little to see if you will go through with it even if it looks like you will fail, or lose. Real fighters are so few that He might even bless you in ways you never thought possible.
- 25. Lift up the anchor, set the sails, and shove off from land for a God adventure. Make sure you set the sails according to the charts and readings, the Bible and

receiving directly from the Lord, so you avoid a disaster, and then sail into the Will of God.



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Launch an Attack

26. When you stop attacking, pioneering, creating or making progress it shows that you have lost initiative. Any army, business, project or person that ceases to attack loses the momentum of power as going on initiative to the attack creates power and progress. It is going on the attack that brings victory and settling down that brings defeat.

- 27. When we give up or compromise, the enemy will then launch a counter attack because we have let down our guard and ceased to advance. An army, individual or project's immobility, lack of vision will cause it to have a loss of faith in its cause.
- 28. The Devil can NEVER win; the only way the Enemy can win is to persuade you that you have a hopeless cause so you might as well quit and leave the field to him. Yet, as we dig in and launch an attack, there is nothing he can do to stop it.
- 30. The only way we can lose the war is if we stop attacking, give up and lose the faith to go on initiative in winning new ground spiritually; in souls, in giving out the Word, in praying regularly for others, for creating publications, and channels of truth. As we go on the attack the Lord fights for us, gives us the joy of inspiration, the thrill of progress.
- 31. We have to keep absorbing the Word into our souls that kindles the fire to attack otherwise we will faint in our minds, give up and backslide. Then we go down the chain reaction backwards

of what makes a fighter, pioneer, creator. You'll stop fighting because you will lose the courage to take the initiative to advance. The Word creates vision, and vision spurs you to action.

- 32. Christianity, churchianity settled down to enjoy what they had instead of launching attacks to win new souls, to make real disciples, to pour out the truth on the world. They ceased to attack which led to compromise with the world. They lost the battle of the spirit.
- 33. God's law of progress is, if you don't continue to gain and increase, then you lose what you've got. We can increase the treasures of truth we have by sharing with those who don't have. There is nothing God loves more and the devil hates more than a Word filled believer giving the truth to others. We need to find the ways to give to others.
- 34. A lot of these classes in the School of Prophets are good for others. They are not just for you. Portions of them or even whole classes may be just what others need. We have to have 'ammunition' that is palatable, relatable, and inspirational as many people will be turned off

to straight scripture, but if it is explained in an interesting way, it may be just what they need.

- 35. In the next two months I plan to create a series of tracts and pamphlets from the classes that you can use to send to others. Some people don't understand the Bible and how it relates. Many get the impression that Christianity is just another religion of rules and 'don'ts', instead of the powerful, life giving joy that is in Jesus Christ.
- 36. Let's go on the attack to reach this world, to give others a chance and get the blessing of God. If we do and fulfill His Word, His Will, His need, then He will give to us our needs and wants. We must put Him and His job first and then all these things will be added to us.

The World is waiting for answers. They search everywhere looking for some hope, some truth, some reality and some real love. We are their answer for we have Jesus Christ in us, the Holy Spirit anointing us, and the Word of God to empower us.

38. And though this world, with devils filled, should threaten to undo us, we will not fear, for God has willed his truth to triumph through us. The prince of darkness grim, we tremble not for him; his rage we can endure, for lo! his doom is sure; one little word shall fell him.

That Word above all earthly powers no thanks to them abideth; the Spirit and the gifts are ours through him who with us sideth. Let goods and kindred go, this mortal life also; the body they may kill:

God's truth abideth still;

His kingdom is forever! (Luther)
