



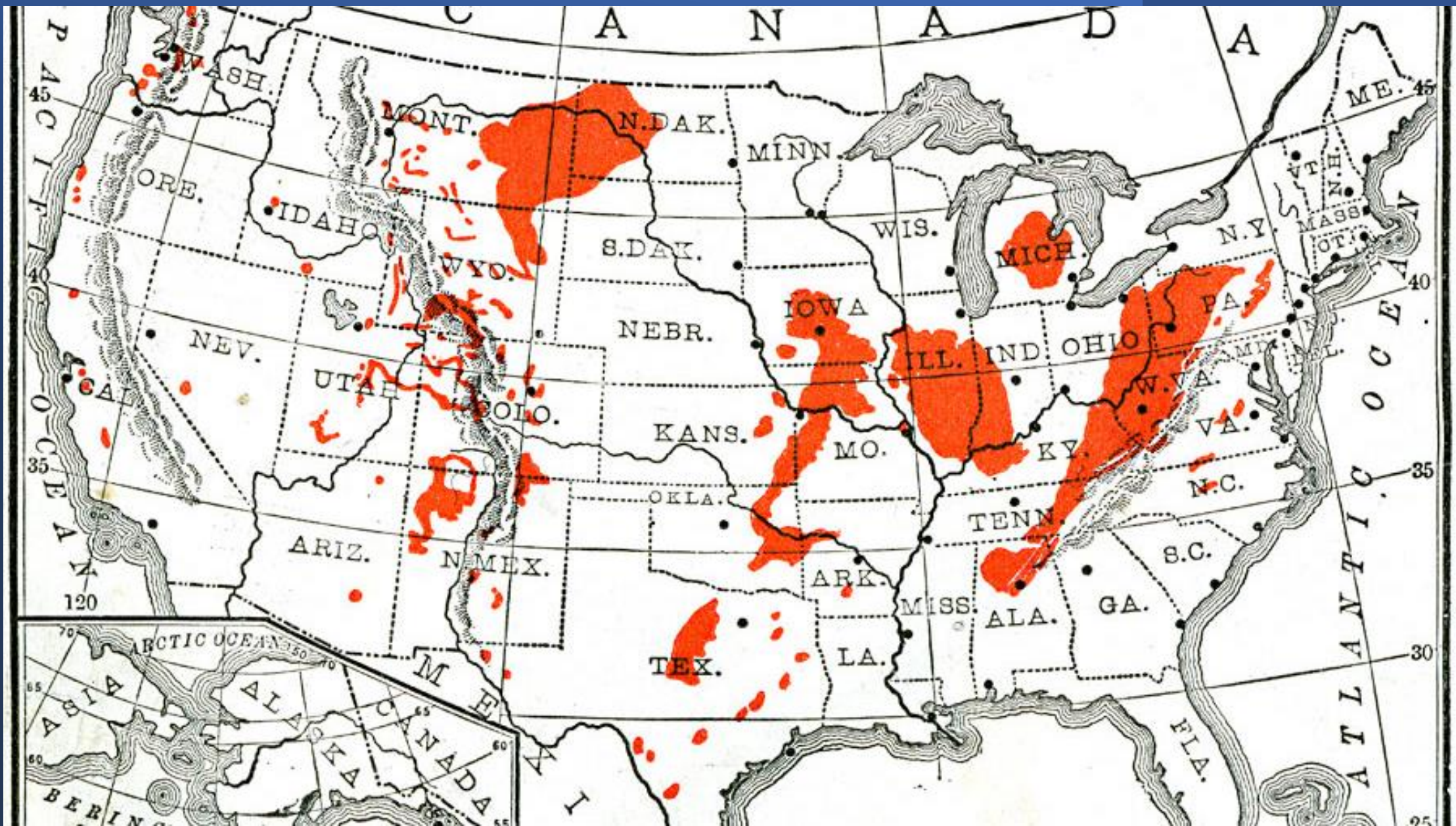

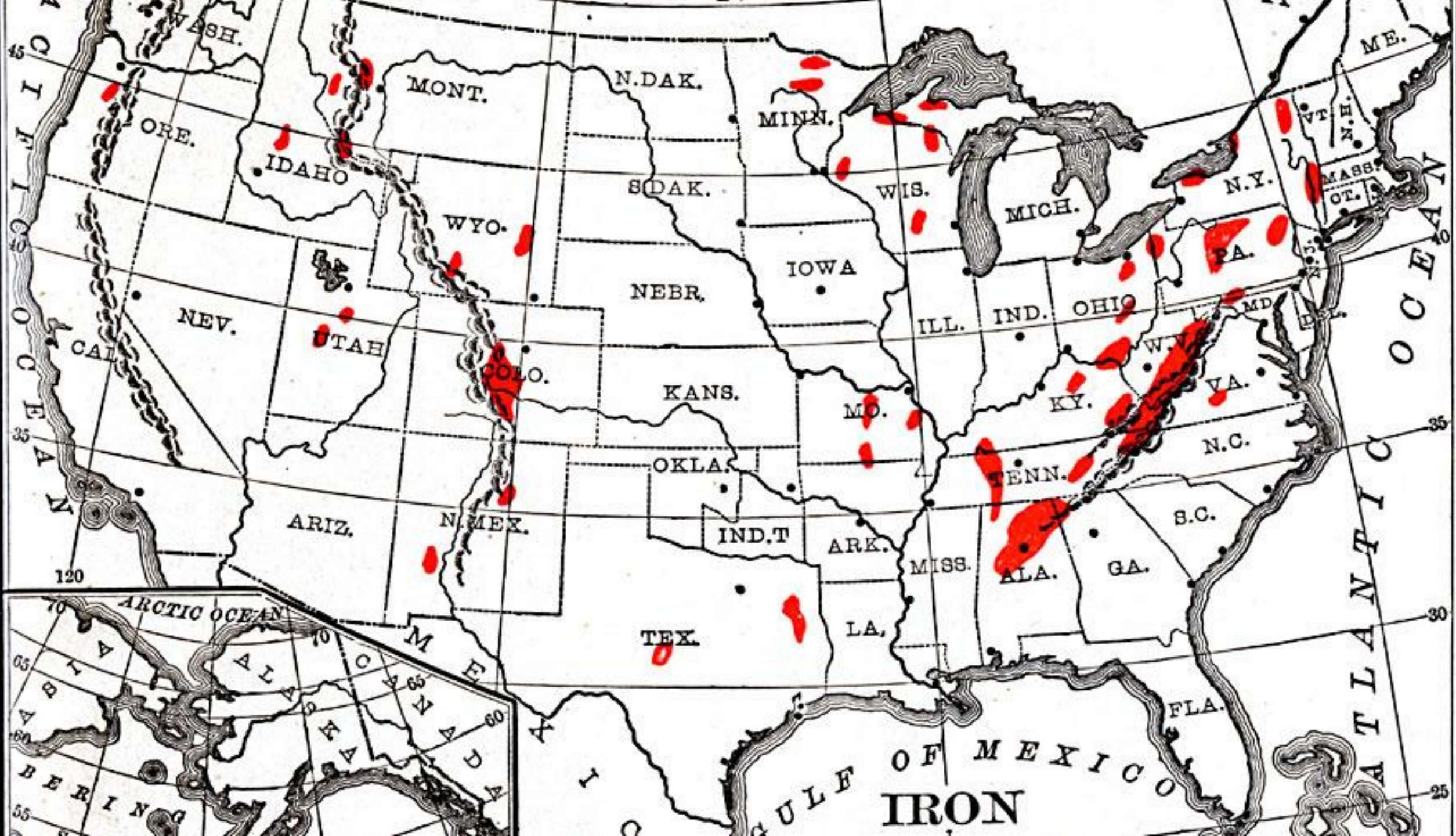

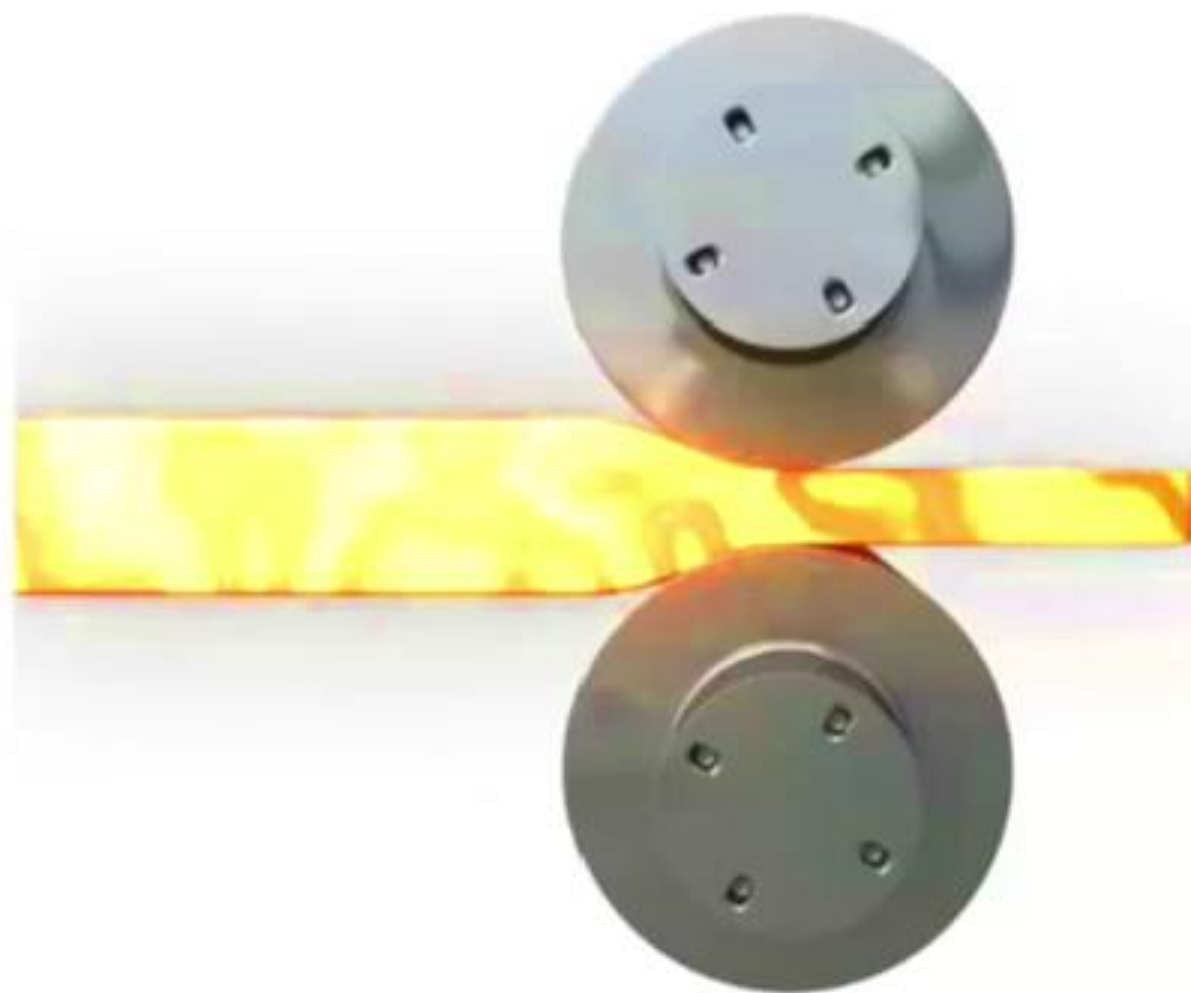

TURNUED TO ACCOUNT.

Bernard Lauth went to work in a Pittsburg rolling mill when he was eleven years old and at thirty, by industry and frugality, he had become manager and part owner of a small iron plant. One day, in examining some iron which, it was thought, a careless workman had spoiled in rolling, he found, to his surprise, that the supposed worthless iron was superior in many respects to that produced by the best equipped mills. Lauth said nothing, but at once began to search for the cause of the singular change. The result of his own experiments and his workman's carelessness was what is known among iron men as the cold rolled process. In consequence of his discovery his small plant in a few years had grown into a mammoth establishment and he and his partners were millionaires.—Success.
